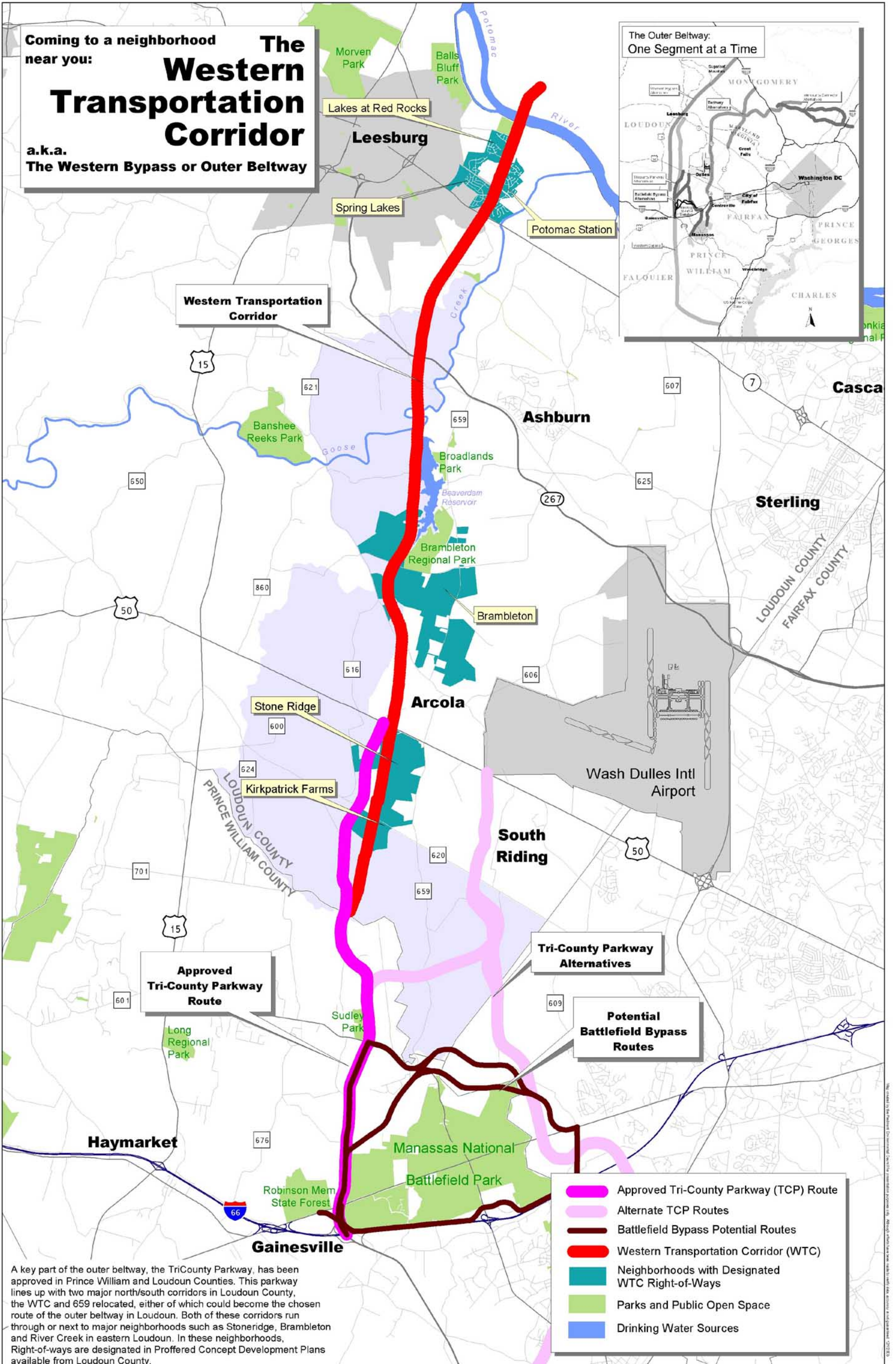
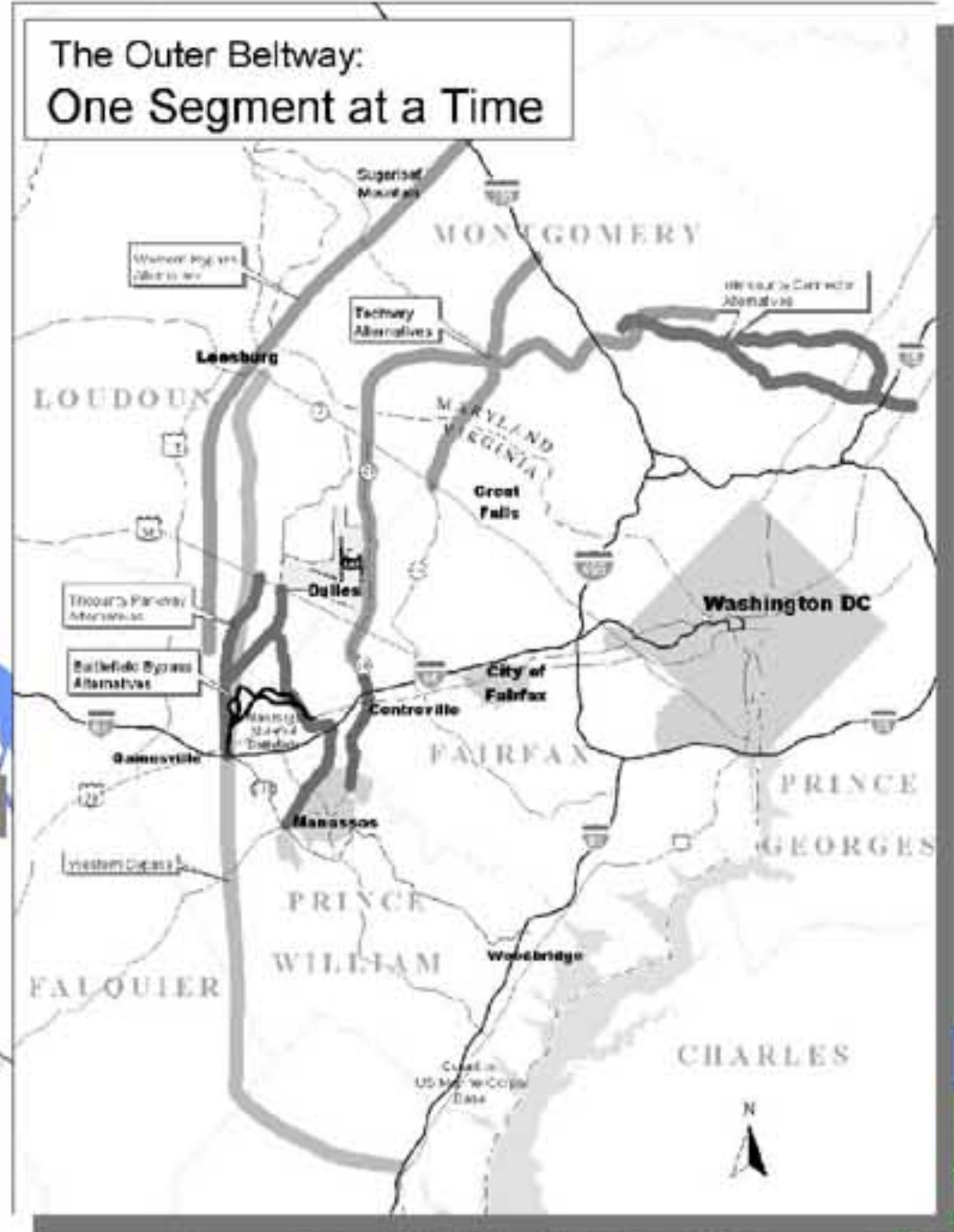


Coming to a neighborhood near you:

A key part of the outer beltway, the TriCounty Parkway, has been approved in Prince William and Loudoun Counties. This parkway lines up with two major north/south corridors in Loudoun County, the WTC and 659 relocated, either of which could become the chosen route of the outer beltway in Loudoun. Both of these corridors run through or next to major neighborhoods such as Stoneridge, Brambleton and River Creek in eastern Loudoun. In these neighborhoods, Right-of-ways are designated in Proffered Concept Development Plans available from Loudoun County.
